



## Information letter to parents about benchmarking study 2025

Dear Parents,

Kolding Municipality and thus XX day-care institution participate in the research and development project called Learning Leadership (2021-2029). The project is a continuation of the Programme for Learning Leadership (2015-2019). Together with researchers from Aalborg University, we work to create the best possible environment for well-being, learning, and development for all children.

As a part of this collaboration, questionnaire surveys were carried out respectively during 2016, 2017, 2019, 2021 and 2023. The surveys were answered by 4-6-year-old children, parents, pedagogues, staff members, and the management. We have been working continuously with the results, and now is the time to carry out a new questionnaire survey and evaluation.

With effect from Monday the 15<sup>th</sup> of September 2025 to the 12<sup>th</sup> of October 2025, a questionnaire survey is to be conducted throughout the municipality, which should be answered by children born during 2019, 2020, and 2021, as well as by parents, pedagogical staff, and management.

Children born during 2019, 2020, and 2021, parents, pedagogical staff, and management will be provided with an access code, which replaces the name and address. Our staff will help the children answer the questionnaire in the day-care institution. The questions relate to the child's experience of well-being, learning, play, and activities.

We ask you to answer the questionnaire using the provided link and password. The questions focus on your child's well-being, learning, and development, as well as your experience of cooperation with us and among parents.

The questionnaire can be answered using a mobile phone, iPad / tablet, and PC, and it will be possible to answer the questionnaire in the day-care institution. One questionnaire must be completed per child. Completing the questionnaire should take no more than 15 minutes.

It is voluntary to take part in the survey, but we encourage you to participate in order to develop our institution to belong amongst the best, and thus we need your contribution. A higher response rate ensures more knowledge, and we hope that many will help us. It is also important that the voices of your child/children are heard.
